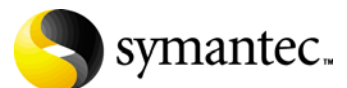

New supported operating system

Symantec ESM modules for Sybase ASE supports installation on the following new operating system:

- AIX 5.3 (PPC) 64-bit

New check in the Sybase ASE Object module

Symantec ESM modules for Sybase ASE adds one new check in the Sybase ASE Object module.

Exclude granted object perm

The Exclude granted object perm check excludes granted object permissions that the Granted object permission check reports.

256-bit AES encryption

The encryption that is used to store the credentials is 256-bit AES encryption algorithm.

Silent installation of ESM modules for Sybase ASE

You can silently install the ESM modules for Sybase ASE by using the `esmsyb2.tpi`.

Silent configuration of ESM modules for Sybase ASE

You can silently configure the ESM modules for Sybase ASE by using the `SybaseSetup`.

Configuration logs

The ESM Sybase Module now creates configuration logs while configuring the Sybase ASE Servers.

Resolved issues and enhancements

The following issues are resolved in ESM for Sybase Adaptive Server Enterprise 2.0:

AIX 5.3 (PPC) 64-bit

Symantec ESM modules for Sybase ASE has now been enhanced to install on the AIX 5.3 (PPC) 64-bit operating system.

Sybase ASE Object (UNIX)	Added a new check Exclude granted object permission, which excludes granted object permissions that are reported by the Granted object permission check. There is a pre-defined template for this check that includes entries of the default permissions that are granted by the Sybase ASE server.
Sybase ASE Object (UNIX)	The template Sybase ASE Object Permissions has been enhanced to report logins or users that have permissions to execute the DBCC commands. The template is applicable for the Object permission check.
Sybase ASE Auditing (UNIX)	The following Audit Options checks refer to templates, which have been modified to report on objects, such as database, procedures, triggers, tables, views and so on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Procedure Audit Options ■ Object Audit Options ■ Login Audit Options ■ Database Audit Options ■ Global Audit Options
Sybase ASE Patches module (HP-UX)	The Sybase ASE Patches module has been modified to correctly report the Patch information on HP-UX.
Sybase ASE Password Strength (UNIX)	The wordlist files that are used in the Password Strength module for agents on UNIX are now not windows-encoded. As a result, the checks in the Password Strength module report correctly on the UNIX agents.
SybaseSetup -a option (UNIX)	The -a option is now corrected to let you add new configuration records for undetected Sybase ASE servers.

Known issue

The following issue is known in this release of Symantec ESM modules for Sybase ASE:

- The RDL logs related to Sybase modules generate errors if RDL 6.5.3 or RDL 6.5.3 SP1 is configured.
 To solve this issue, upgrade RDL 6.5.3 or RDL 6.5.3 SP1 to RDL 6.5.3 SP2 or later.
